For the duration of the scholarship, Dingwall Trust agrees to:

1. Pay all School Boarding fees as required by the nominated school from time to time.
2. Pay all School tuition fees as required by the school from time to time.
3. Supply all regulation school uniform clothing as required by the school at the start of the scholar's attendance and at the time the scholar becomes a senior student when this requires a full change of uniform.
4. Supply the stationery required by the school for the student's use at the start of the scholar's attendance and at the start of each school year, not including previously purchased, non-consumable items such as, but not limited to, calculators, maths sets, scissors, ruler.
5. Pay for such extra curricula school activities as are agreed to in negotiation between the scholar and the Director, The Dingwall Trust.
6. Provide support for the scholar by linking with school staff and the student once a term and/or as otherwise requested by the school.
7. Review the scholarship regularly with all concerned with a formal review in October of each year. Such review and school reports to form the basis for consideration by The Dingwall Trust to extension or termination of the scholarship.

Agrees to:

1. Supply all incidental needs of the scholar; as required by the school, and as arise from day to day for the scholar including but not limited to medical expenses, toiletries, cosmetics, socks/stockings, taxis, telephone calls, pocket money.
2. Meet, or assist in meeting, the costs of such extra curricula activities, agreed to by me/us that the scholar takes part in.
3. Organise for the scholar to be at home or otherwise cared for over school leave weekends and holiday periods.
4. Provide transportation for the scholar to and from the school for leave weekends and holiday periods.
5. Support the scholar in his/her schooling by visiting the school for open days and parent days, and by offering encouragement.
6. Provide casual clothing for the scholar's use at school as required by the school and for use at home for weekends and holidays.
7. Replace the scholar's worn/lost/outgrown uniform items as required.
8. Replenish the scholar's stationery supplies as required.
9. Support the scholar's attendance at the Dingwall Orientation Camp
