Who are we and what do we do?



We are a team of support people for teenagers leaving state care. Our aim is to assist young people to make a supported journey from care to living successfully in their community

Who does Supported Boarding help?



Young people from age 17, who are now leaving care and require a supportive living environment

Why do we need Supported Boarders?



Young people leaving care have often not yet gained the skills they will require to become a successful, functioning member of their community. Therefore we need people from all walks of life, who understand the difficulties facing young people today and have a room to let in their home.

What we provide for the Young Person:



A Personal Advisor to work along side the young person, supporting them through their transition. This includes assisting the young person to identify their strengths, needs and goals and helping them to plan to meet those goals. The Personal Advisor can help the young person to access any other services or programs that may benefit them through their transition.

What we provide for the Supported Boarding Provider:



A Housing Coordinator to assist with the tenancy details of the young person. This person's focus is the support of our housing providers – they provide advice, assistance and a regular touch base to ensure that the placement is working out.
